

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND BY-LAWS
OF
TIMNEY SOUTH RIVER PARK COMMUNITY CEMETERY

- (1) THE NAME shall be TIMNEY SOUTH RIVER PARK COMMUNITY CEMETERY, and hereinafter is referred to as The Cemetery.
- (2) THE SOUTH RIVER PARK COMMUNITY, for the purpose of this document, is defined as, "Persons residing and owning property in an area bounded on the East by Fish River, on the North by Cowpen Branch, on the West by County Road 27, on the South by Water Hole Branch," and hereinafter is referred to as The Community.
- (3) A GOVERNING COMMITTEE composed of six members of The Community, elected by The Community, hereinafter referred to as The Committee, shall serve a three year term, with the terms of office rotated in such manner that two members are elected annually. The committee members may be permitted to serve two consecutive terms and after a lapse of two years, one who has previously served may be re-elected.

The Committee shall choose its own chairperson, vice-chairperson, and secretary/treasurer. The Committee shall conduct The Cemetery's business in accordance with the By-Laws of The Cemetery. Four Committee members comprise a quorum for conducting a regular meeting of The Committee.
- (4) LOT OWNERSHIP in The Cemetery is restricted to The Community. Exceptions may be made by The Committee. Lots are not transferable and no refunds shall be made. Reassignment to owners' family members shall be subject to approval of The Committee.
- (5) THE GENERAL APPEARANCE of The Cemetery shall be maintained at the discretion of The Committee and no trees or shrubbery shall be planted without permission of the Committee.

- (6) CHARGES are as follows. These charges are to be reviewed regularly by The Committee and are subject to change.
- (a) The Cemetery shall charge \$150 for each gravesite or \$400 for a plot of four (4) gravesites.
 - (b) The Cemetery shall charge \$10 for staking out a grave for burial and two members of The Committee shall be present to stake out a grave.
 - (c) There will be a \$10 yearly assessment per owner for maintenance of The Cemetery, payable on or before the first Saturday of October each year.
- (7) PERMANTE MARKERS chosen and furnished by owner's, must mark each grave WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS after interment. To ensure that a maker will be placed on each grave, The Committee will collect a fee, equal to current costs for a generic marker at the time each grave is opened. This amount will be held for six (6) months by The Cemetery. If the family places the permanent marker on the grave within said six (6) month period, The Cemetery will refund the fee. If no marker is place on the grave within the six (6) month period, The Committee will use the fee to place a marker on the grave.
- (8) WORKDAYS are scheduled for the first Saturdays in April and October of each year. Election of The Committee and an Annual Business Meeting shall be in conjunction with the October workday.
- (9) VAULT IS REQUIRED for all interments. In the event of cremation, cremation urns are acceptable.
- (10) CREMATIONS - No more than two (2) cremations shall be placed in each grave sight.
